I checked in with Helen this week and she informed me that the church has just received its 5-year Grade 1 building inspection and survey, that the Diocese require - so they are working their way through the report and its priorities for repairs needed - all of which have to be compliant with the Grade 1 listed building requirements, so quite a task.

The new part of the consecrated church yard, above the allotments, has already been used for burials and is now being used as an option for cremation ash memorials.

The church wardens, volunteers and staff have been working exceptionally hard to keep the mud under control in the churchyard and around the building during the terrific amounts of rain we've been experiencing and have been justifiably quite upset by receiving some complaints about the mud, from people seemingly not aware of the considerable efforts that have been deployed to resolve the climate caused issue.
